SHOW CAR CLASSIFICATIONS

Street Stock

- Factory stock appearance. Reproduction and replacement parts allowed if they appear to be period correct. There may be minor allowances for some add on or modified components. Generally speaking these should be kept to 3 or less depending severity of modifications. Body, exterior, interior, paint, wheels, engine compartment should maintain as much as a stock appearance as possible. Allowances for different tires, as long as size appears to be appropriate, wheels may be aftermarket but should resemble stock wheels. Interior may have slight changes such as added arm rests, steering wheel cover, mild decals, shifter modification, carpet floor mats.
- Exterior paint may be of a different shade or color than original, however, the color must be of a colored offered by GM in that year for Corvettes.

Modified

- Mild changes to body, engine, interior, including custom wheels, bolt-on body parts, paint, non-original GM color, pinstripes, etc.
- Add on such as moon roofs, spoilers that are bolted on, location of antenna, different grill, bubble tail lights, exhaust, graphics (interior, under hood, trunk, etc.)
- Shifters, radio, modifications to seats and carpet are acceptable modifications as long as they are not WILD CUSTOMS
- Additional chrome components under the hood and interior
- There should be reasonable number of modifications to be in the Modified Class
- If the car is basically stock with only a couple modifications it should be in Street Stock. If in doubt check with Judging chairman for decision

Custom

- Radical changes to body, engine, interior roll bars, molded body panels such as spoilers, bumpers, fender flairs, paint graphics, custom paint schemes are all Custom (ghost flames, murals, heavy metallic paint, fogging, wraps)
- Tilt front ends, changes to interior design such as rolled and pleated, changes to seat designs, after market radios and speakers, TVs
- Lights including LED, additional lights

Custom Continued:

- Engine compartment designs, hidden wires and hoses, blowers, superchargers, of the non- stock variety
- Door openings and operation, shaved door handles, and remote entry mechanism
- Race prepared, missing major body components to lighten weight, such as inner fender wells, bumpers, interior components
- Race prepared cars with paint schemes, decals, roll bars, mismatched wheels and tires, missing body components intended to reduce weight, parachutes, etc.
